Norway's Retirement Income System comprises an earnings-related social security pension with a minimum pension level. There are also many voluntary arrangements to provide additional benefits.

*\*Reminder:* Each year, the Index undergoes some small changes. These changes include questions being added, removed or altered, as well as the addition or removal of nations participating in the Index. Although the effects of these changes are very minimal, some of the information in this table can be impacted. A more detailed outline of these changes can be found in Chapter 3 of the Full Report for each edition.

## The 2017 Report's Policy Recommendations

The overall index value for the Norwegian system could be increased by:

- Raising the level of household saving
- Increasing the level of mandatory contributions into the defined contribution plans
- Introducing arrangements to protect all the pension interests of both parties in a divorce.
