**"Trust in Finance: Some International Reflections"**

Ranjit is an experienced international regulator with 25 years of experience in global capital market regulation and development. He was the former Vice Chairman of the Board of the International Organisation of Securities Commissions (IOSCO) and Chair of IOSCO's largest committee on emerging markets and represented IOSCO on the Financial Stability Board. He was also the Chair of the ASEAN Capital Market Forum. He served as Executive Chairman of Securities Commission Malaysia between 2012-2018. Ranjit is currently a securities market expert for the International Monetary Fund and sits on the advisory boards of several countries globally. He is also on the Leadership Council of the United Nations Sustainable Development Solutions Network(M), on the Board of Advisors of the Salzburg Finance Forum, the Board of the Institute of Integrity and Fellow of the Institute of Corporate Directors. Ranjit is a graduate of Monash University, where he was awarded a Bachelor of Economics with Honours and Master of Economics in Finance. In 2013 Monash University awarded Ranjit the Doctor of Laws *honoris causa*. He is a fellow of CPA Australia. He has previously taught finance at the University of Melbourne.
